1. Create an original project or essay.

2. The Rules:

- This work must be an original project for this scholarship, and should not appear on internet or in any other form of publication prior to August 2021.

- **Research using at least one print source and one non-print source. Only use sources that are grade-appropriate and reputable.**

- No Wikipedia or textbooks.

- Forget plagiarism. We check.

- ***Bibliography is a must with any form of presentation.***

3. The Presentations

Written Work

- Typed work of two or three pages or handwritten work of four or five pages. Follow MLA format. (***The bibliography will up the total by one page.***)

Creative Presentation

- This can take many forms: video, audio, slide presentation, photo timeline, graphic novel, etc. (Only choose one style.) We're pretty much open to any type of creative project. However, it has to be a substantial piece of work. For example, a ten page Powerpoint presentation with one or two sentences or bullets per slide will not suffice. Think details.

- For all creative presentations **please submit a paper copy and** a file on CD, thumb drive, scan disk, etc. (if applicable). These items will not be returned, so don't send expensive ones.

- ***Don't forget the bibliography.***

All presentations will be used only for Kingdom of Lucerne scholarship purposes. They will appear nowhere else by our hand.

Scholarship Projects for 2021

Topics

Your project concerns **one** of these early settlements of our country: Henricus in Virginia, New Amsterdam in New York, Popham in Maine, or St. Augustine in Florida.

-Write a personal diary from the viewpoint of someone who might have lived in the early days of the colony.

-Don't use a real person. Include the name, age, and occupation of the diary writer. The occupation has to be one that was known to be done in that colony. Make sure to have information on your occupation in the diary.

-Include real events that happened in the colony (and your reaction to them) as well as fictional events that could have happened to your character.

Project Type (Only choose one.)

- If you type this, it must be at least two pages. Even though it is a diary, follow MLA format concerning footnotes or endnotes. (Pictures, drawing, and bibliography increase the amount of pages.) Handwritten papers should be at least four pages if the paper is 8 ½ x 11". Adjust length as necessary. ***It has to be legible.***

- Create a visual representation of the diary. This could be as simple as a narrated film of the diary being written or your actual hand-written diary (This is different from hand-written papers.). You can use props, costumes, etc. for a video. You can also use various filming techniques to make your project stand out.
